Southlake Regional Health Centre has made restrictions to visiting to minimize the spread of COVID-19.

Prenatal/triage patients are not permitted to have visitors. Exceptions are non-English speaking patients.

Women in active labour, being induced or arriving for a booked c-section are permitted to have one visitor in the form of a support person during their stay at the hospital.

All visitors must screen negative – no fever, respiratory symptoms and/or contact with another person who may be ill upon each entry to the hospital.

This support person must be the same person and when in hospital must continue to wear a mask when within 6 feet of staff and will not be permitted to roam in the hallways.

Support persons are permitted to use the hospital food vendors but must bring food back to the patient room to eat. Dining areas continue to be closed for public use.

Support persons are permitted to leave and return to hospital premises only once per day.

Our visiting policy may change based on provincial direction.
