Radiation Oncologist

The Stronach Regional Cancer Centre at Southlake is seeking a 0.8 FTE Radiation Oncologist to join our team of full-time Radiation Oncologists. The Southlake Radiation Oncology Program serves the needs of the Central LHIN with a diverse geography and a population of 1.4 million people. The Radiation Centre is located in Newmarket, Ontario, has four linear accelerators (will be installing a 5th over the next year), and is closely aligned with the Cancer Programs at six partner hospitals in the Central LHIN where Surgical and Medical Oncology programs are delivered. The SRCC also has partnerships with the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre, The University of Toronto, and the Odette Cancer Centre, as well as cooperative groups for clinical trials.

The Radiation Medicine Program aspires to integrate the care of patients throughout the LHIN through active collaboration with, and a physical presence at, the surgical and medical programs at partner hospitals. Southlake is evolving new models of inter-professional patient care through innovation, education and academic partnerships. The Program currently treats tumours of the lung, breast, GI and GU, skin and lymphoma. It has an active program in lung SBRT and a developing program in SBRT for oligometastatic tumours.

The successful candidate must be eligible for licensing in Ontario and have certification in Radiation Oncology from the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada, and be eligible for appointment to the University of Toronto, in the Department of Radiation Oncology. Knowledge and experience in treating a variety of tumour sites will be an asset.
