## PALLIATIVE MEDICINE PHYSICIAN

Southlake is seeking a 1.0 FTE Palliative Medicine Physician to join our vibrant, diverse, and supportive interdisciplinary team that includes seven physicians on staff. Southlake has a unique continuity of care model in which the selected physician has the opportunity to follow their patients in multiple settings.

The selected candidate would support the team with inpatient consultations, outpatient clinics in the Stronach Regional Cancer Centre and Aging Well Non-Malignant Clinic, MRP for PCU and Margaret Bahen Hospice Beds, as well as community home visits. On-Call is approximately 1 every 7 weeks with CPOC funding.

We are a University of Toronto, Division of Palliative Care, teaching site with Family Medicine Residents and an elective site for palliative PGY3 students. The successful candidate will be licensed to practice medicine in Ontario and have additional palliative medicine training and/or experience. Remuneration will be under the fee-for-service model.

Ideal start date would be August 2024; however, this is flexible depending on candidate availability.
